	In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.	
	In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.	
	Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

Clothing / Advertising	Tournament will be conducted according to the BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations 12 to 16, but the name on the back of the shirt is optional.	

Badminton Integrity	Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and antimatch manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament. To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match. Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es). For more information, please refer to BWF's website.
Doping Control	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). The hostel is available starting from June 22, not later than July 2. The hostel does not offer breakfast, but there is a shared kitchen on site. Guests are provided with bed linen, except towels. Practice courts	Practice courts will be made available at requested times, on Wednesday, June 25 afternoon, before the tournament, as well as on Thursday, June 26 , before the start of the tournament. Players will also be able to practice on tournament days until 22:30. The times will be specified on the <u>Tournament website</u> , specifying the number of tournament participants.			
Training camp before and after the tournament	Before and after the tournament (from June 22 to July 2), it is possible to organize training sessions 2-3 times a day in the Tournament Hall and stay in the Hostel of Tournament Hall. Players and coaches will have 3 or 6 courts at their disposal. These can be both individual training sessions and training camps. See information about the Hostel in the Accomodation section.
