Visas	After entering player(s) in the tournament it is the Member's responsibility to secure visas for their players – if this is needed. The Tournament Organisers will do everything possible to enable the entered players to get a visa. For assistance to the organisers of the visa paperwork, affected players are asked to send information no later than 23 rd May to email: <u>vli@badminton.lv</u> The following information on the foreigner being invited shall be given: -name (-s) and surname -citizenship (nationality) -date and place of birth -coppy of passport -arrival and departure dates -the address of the place of residence -the location (office) where the visa application will likely be submitted
	Visa costs will be determined in accordance with the <u>State fees of the Office</u> of <u>Citizenship and Migration Affairs of Republic of Latvia</u> and must be paid by Member or visa applicant.
Force Majeure	The organising Member can cancel a tournament in case of force majeure. Such cancellation must be announced at least 15 days before the start of the tournament. If a cancellation is announced less than 15 days before the start of the tournament, then the Member organising the tournament is liable for any expenses incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.). Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons because of a cancellation of a tournament.
Waiver	Member and/or Organiser may be liable for claims originating from the damages incurred by the participants and/or any other persons, arising from or in connection to the particular BEC Elite Circuit tournament, according to local Law.
