Eligible Players	All players of clubs affiliated through their National Associations to the BWF
Conditions of Play	<p>The tournament will be played in full accordance with the laws of Badminton and General Competition Regulations adopted by the BWF as well as the regulations of the Badminton Europe's Elite Circuit. The tournament draw sizes are limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -100 matches per day -2 rounds per event per day for the main draw -no more than 3 qualifying rounds per day for a maximum of 8 places in any event <p>If more players/pairs enter the competition than the organisers can accept even in the qualifying rounds, the World Ranking shall be used to determine the players/pairs whose entries can be accepted into the qualifying draw and which entry to fill any subsequent vacancy that may arise</p> <p>Competitors must be prepared to play at the times quoted in the order of play for the events for which they were entered</p> <p>Competitors can be scratched if not ready to play when called. Players shall not plan their departure less than 2 (two) hours after their last match is planned to conclude. If a player is unable to compete due to early departure, he/she shall be penalised by Forfeiture of rewards (removal of Elite Circuit ranking points and shall not be awarded prizes or prize money). Badminton Europe shall propose to BWF that the gained BWF ranking points are also removed (as in §9.5). The seeding and the draw will be done by Badminton Europe</p>

Practice Courts	<p>On 28th and 29th August there is possibility to rent court/courts in same Venue (wooden floor) for practice. Price is 12€/per hour 1 court. For rent 8 courts available. Starting from 30th August same 8 courts will be available for warm-up free of charge.</p> <p>Courts for 28th and 29th August need to be booked in advance, no later than 23rd August via email: arturs@badminton.lv</p>
Entries	<p>All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System. Entries must be submitted no later than Tuesday 1st August 2023 at 23:59 BWF HQ time (GMT +08.00). Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID-number. In case you wish to enter players who do not have a BWF ID-number yet, please use the Tournament Software to register new players before the closing date of the tournament.</p>

Entry Fees	<p>Singles: 40€ per player Doubles: 35€ per player per event</p> <p>The Member that enters a player into a BEC Elite Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.</p>

Prize Money	<p>There is no prize money for this tournament</p>
Withdrawals	<p>Any withdrawal after the Monday immediately preceding the draw, for any reason whatsoever, renders the Member concerned liable to an amount of US\$ 150,00 for the inconvenience caused by the withdrawal (as defined in BWF General Competition Regulations) (as in §22.1).</p> <p>Any player not showing up for a match at the tournament, without having been withdrawn in advance, renders the Member concerned liable to an additional amount of US\$ 500,00 for the inconvenience caused by the "no show" (as defined in BWF General Competition Regulations) (as in §22.2).</p>
Visas	<p>After entering player(s) in the tournament it is the Member's responsibility to secure visas for their players – if this is needed. The Tournament Organisers will do everything possible to enable the entered players to get a visa.</p> <p>For assistance to the organisers of the visa paperwork, affected players are asked to send information no later than 09th August to email: arturs@badminton.lv</p> <p>The following information on the foreigner being invited shall be given:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -name (-s) and surname -citizenship (nationality) -date and place of birth -the address of the place of residence -the location (office) where the visa application will likely be submitted

	<p>Visa costs will be determined in accordance with the State fees of the Office of Citizenship and Migration Affairs of Republic of Latvia</p>
<p>Minimum Amount of Entries</p>	<p>In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.1: World Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking, i.e. BEC Elite Circuit Ranking and BWF World Ranking. In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.1: World Ranking System, the first published version of the main draw of an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking. Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings (as in §3.3).</p>
<p>Tournament Cancellation</p>	<p>The organising Member can cancel the tournament in case of force majeure. Such cancellation must be announced at least 15 days before the start of the tournament. If a cancellation is announced less than 15 days before the start of the tournament, then the Member organising the tournament is liable for any expenses incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.). Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons because of a cancellation of a tournament (as in §3.4).</p>
<p>Transport</p>	<p>Official points of arrival: -Riga passenger Railway station -Riga International Coach Terminal (Bus station) -Riga international Airport (RIX)</p> <p>Transport is only free of charge for players staying at the tournament official hotel (for accommodation booking see below)</p> <p>Transport can also be provided for other players from airport to any other hotel in the city area of Riga but then charged as follows: -30€ one person for both directions from/to airport -40€ two persons for both directions from/to airport -50€ 3 or 4 persons for both directions from/to airport</p> <p>All requests for transport booking should be sent to email: arturs@badminton.lv not later than 18th August.</p> <p>There is good public transport in Riga available. Even from Riga International Airport you can use public Bus Nr.22 to get to the city centrum. Cost for one transport ticket is 2€, daily ticket 5€, ticket for 3 days 8€. Closing and Advertising Regulations	<p>Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to BWF. It is mandatory that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts at all time during play in both the qualification and the main draw. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 100,00 EUR (as in §18)</p>
Medical	<p>A physiotherapist and First aid nurse will be present in the Sports hall during the tournament and a medical doctor will be on call.</p>
Doping Control	<p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any</p>

	<p>medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). For more information about anti-doping, please visit the BWF website: https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-doping-overview/</p>
Badminton Integrity	<p>Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament. To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match. Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).
